As a parent myself, I would like to purchase materials that my child would actually use in class. Thank you for your support and consideration!

- 4 boxes of Crayola brand (this is the best brand) crayons (24 count)
- 12 glue sticks (or more!! We go through these so fast!!!)
- 1 box of washable markers
- 1 package of dry erase markers (any color)
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (this brand cuts the best!) or any blunted end scissor.
- 2 spiral notebooks/ or 2 composition books
- 2 boxes of 24 count wooden pencils
- Pencil cap erasers/ or 4 large pink erasers
- 6 plastic or paper folders with prongs and pockets
- Plastic pencil box (please write student name on this)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 band aid boxes
- 2 packages of baby wipes
- Ziploc bags (sandwich, gallon, snack, quart— we use these frequently!)
- Paper plates (dinner and snack size)
- Hand sanitizer
- 2 canisters Lysol Disinfecting wipes (I am a BIG cleaner!!)
